

INSTRUCTIONS

Thanks for purchasing this add-on. To load the brushes please follow the instructions below.

Open the file called 'Vector Rope Brushes.EPS', using the file/open menu. The brushes will now be appear in 'Brushes Tab'. Also included in the pack is a back-saved version of the brushes that can be opened in Illustrator CS1 and later, these open in the same way.

To use the brushes...

1. Use any of Illustrator's drawing tools to create a line.
2. Open the Brushes Tab by accessing the 'Windows/Brushes' menu.
3. Select your shape with the Selection Tool (Not the Direct Selection Tool).
4. Click on one of the brush icons in the Brushes tab and the rope brush will be applied to the shape.

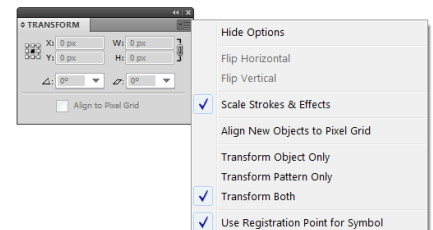
Tips -

You can change the colour of your rope by amending the colour of the shape's stroke. This applies to all of the brushes except 'ROPE BRUSH 5' which comes ready coloured. Another version of this brush has been included which can be re-coloured (named **Rope Brush _Torn Edges_RECOLOR & Rope Brush 5_RECOLOR**).

To change the width of your border, amend the stroke width as normal.

When creating rope shapes please avoid corners that have angles smaller than 45 degrees. Angles of less than 45 degrees may distort.

If after applying the brush to your shape it looks as if parts of it are bunched up and not displaying properly then make the shape bigger and re-apply the brush. After doing this shrink your shape. When you shrink the shape make sure your transform setting (found on the transform Tab) as set as in the image opposite.
