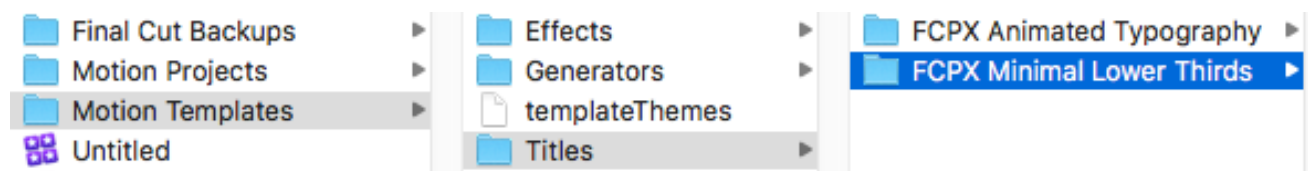

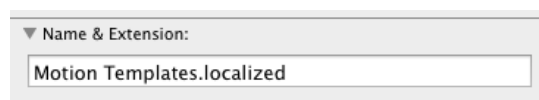

2.1) How to use in Final Cut Pro X:

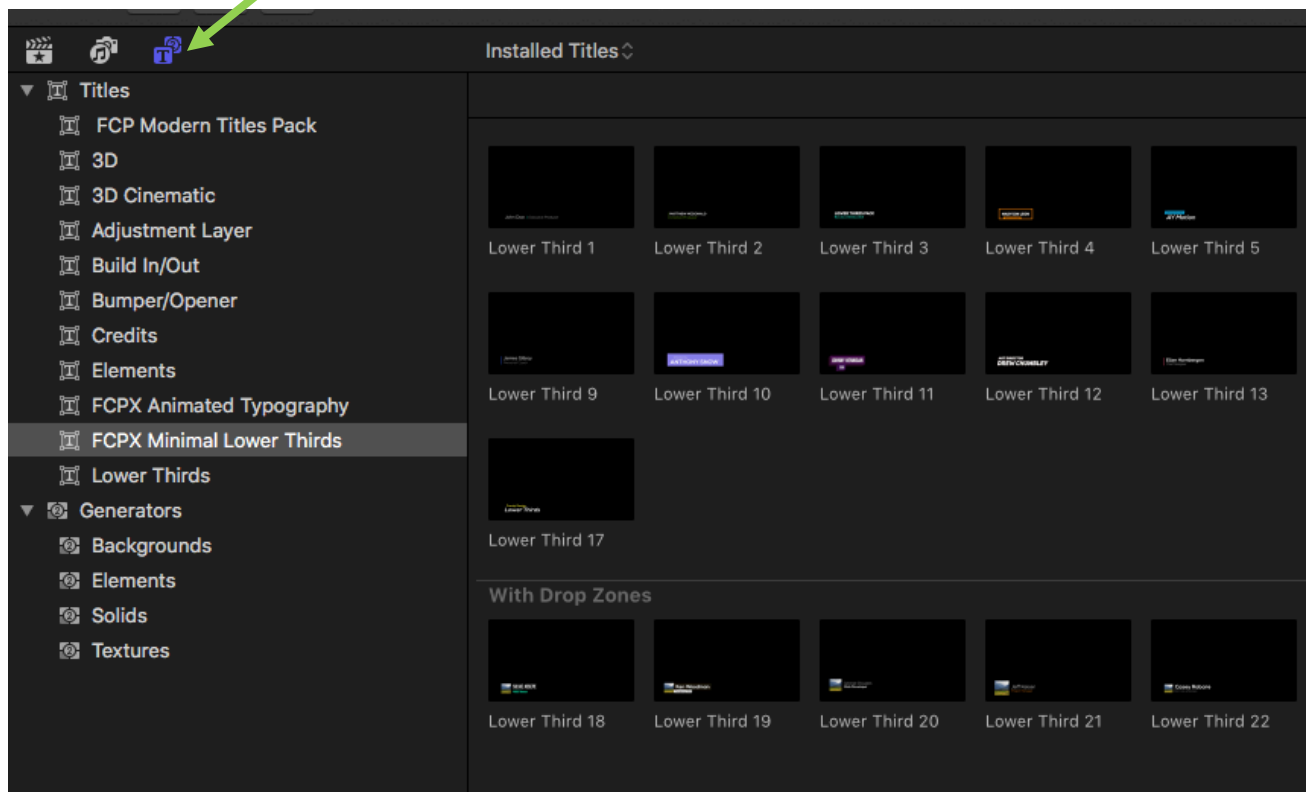
Firstly, copy "FCPX Minimal Lower Thirds" folder to **"Movies -> Motion Templates -> Titles"**



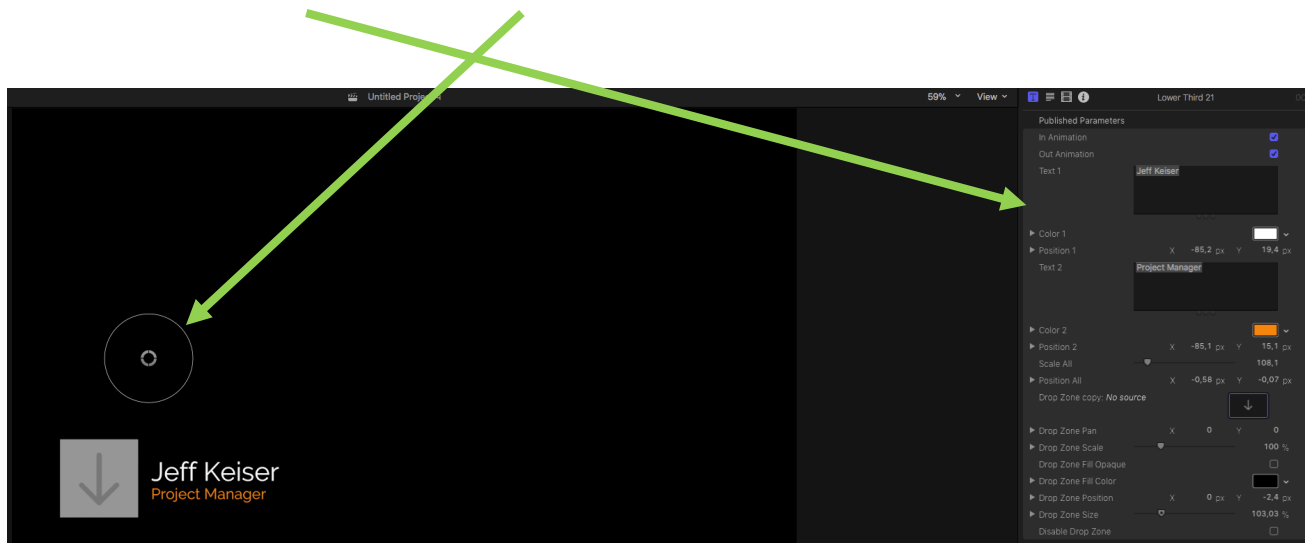
If "Motion Templates" or "Titles" folder does not exist, you have to create it. Folder, that you have created must have a ".localized" extension. To add it, right-click on "Titles" folder and select Get Info (or select the folder and type command-i) and in the Name & Extension text box, change the folder name to "Titles.localized".



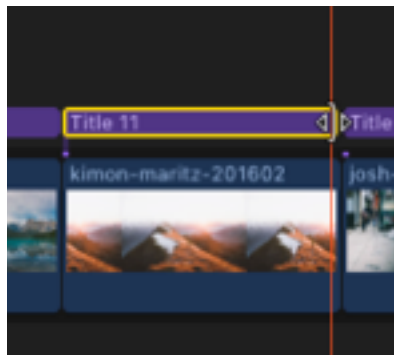
Then open Final Cut Pro press “T” icon for Titles and find “FCPX Minimal Lower Thirds”. Now you can drag any of them to the timeline.



Each title has editable parameters and on screen controls for position and scale.

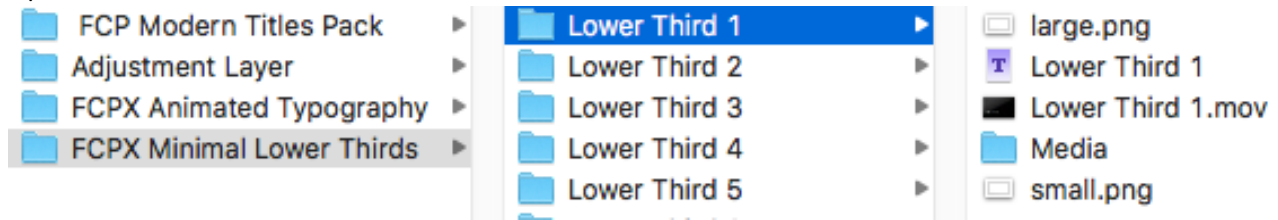


If you want to increase or decrease titles duration, drag the edge of title at the timeline:

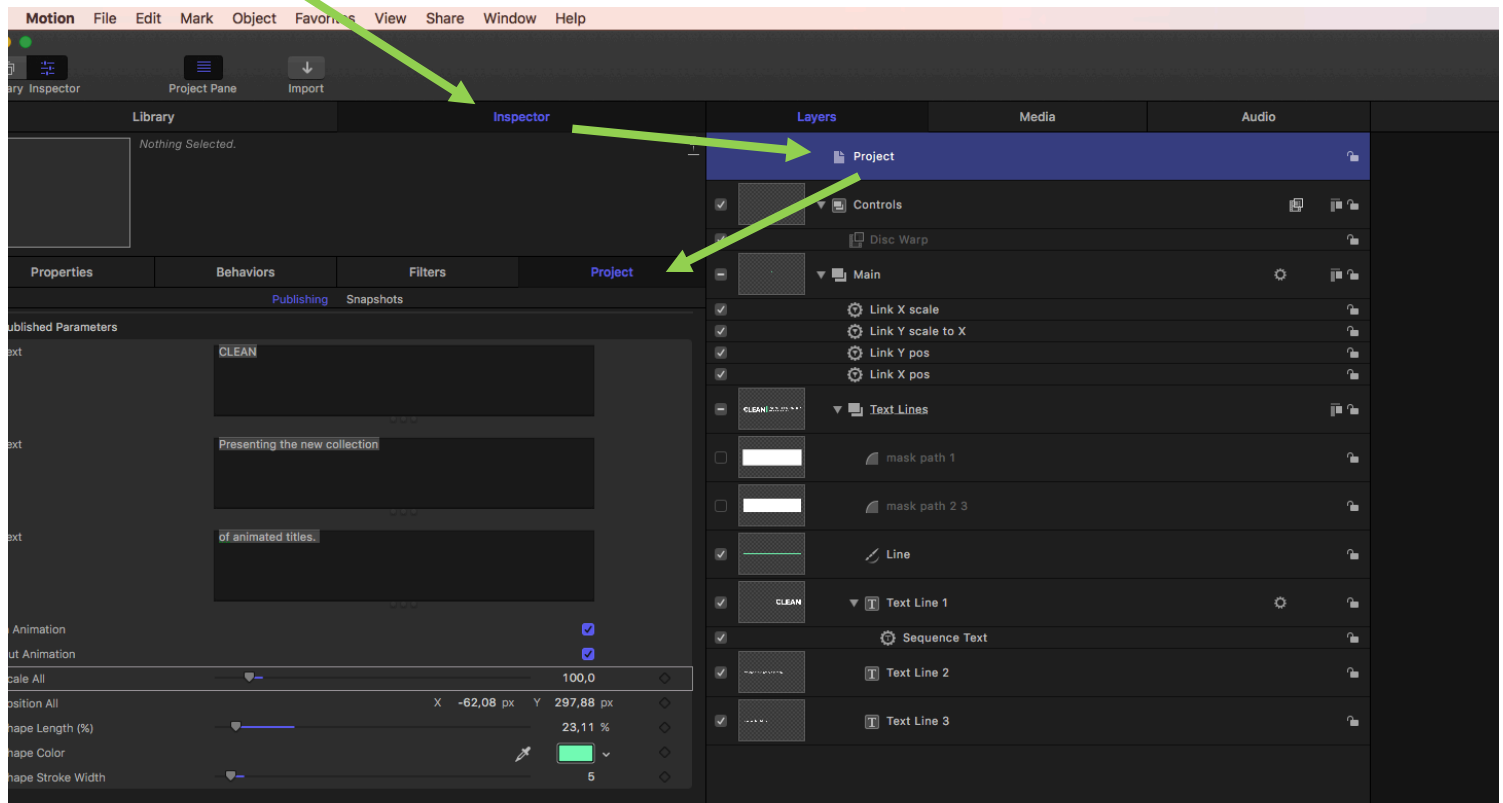


2.2) How to use in Motion 5:

Open “FCPX Minimal Lower Thirds” -> “Title №” -> “Title №.motn”



Go to “Inspector” -> “Project” -> “Project”, edit necessary parameters and render composition.
