of copying the appropriate  
ICC profiles from your  
package into a location on  
your hard drive.

## Mac OS Instructions

Step 1  
Close Lightroom if open.

Step 2  
Please copy the ICC profiles  
**only** (without their enclosing  
folders) from your package  
into the following path on  
your hard drive:

Users > [Your Username] >  
Library > ColorSync >  
Profiles

Step 3  
Launch Lightroom

## Windows OS Instructions

Step 1  
Close Lightroom if open.

Step 2  
Please copy the ICC profiles  
**only** (without their enclosing  
folders) from your package  
into the following path on  
your hard drive:

C:\Windows\System32\  
pool\drivers\color

# APPLYING LUTs

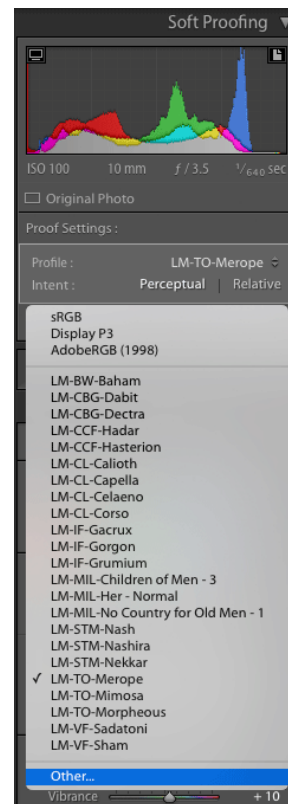
Once installed, Lutify.me LUTs will appear under 'Soft Proofing' option in the 'Develop' tab.

Select the appropriate LUT by selecting it from the drop down list under 'Profile' option in the 'Develop' tab.

If the list of LUTs is not populated with the LUTs you have just copied, select 'Other...' option and add a checkmark next to each and every LUT you would like to add into Lightroom.

Confirm your changes. Your LUTs will now appear in drop-down list and will be available for selection.
