## INSTALLING LUTs

Installing Lutify.me LUTs into Adobe Photoshop

Lightroom differs slightly depending on whether you are using Adobe Photoshop Lightroom Classic CC or Adobe Photoshop Lightroom CC.

Please follow these instructions to install Lutify.me LUTs into your version of **Adobe Photoshop Lightroom Classic CC**.

### Lightroom Classic CC (Mac)

Step 1  
Close Lightroom if open.

Step 2  
Please copy and paste the profiles **with** their enclosing folders from your package into the following path on your hard drive:

Users > [Your Username] > Application Support > Adobe > CameraRaw > Settings

Step 3  
Launch Lightroom

### Lightroom Classic CC (Win)

Step 1  
Close Lightroom if open.

Step 2  
Please copy and paste the profiles **with** their enclosing folders from your package into the following path on your hard drive:

C:\ Users \ [Your Username] \ AppData \ Roaming \ Adobe \ CameraRaw \ Settings

Step 3  
Launch Lightroom

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### Lightroom CC


Step 1  
Launch Lightroom CC.

Step 2  
Click on the three dots in Presets Browser and select 'Import Profiles...'

Step 3  
Select the folder containing profiles in your package and click 'Import'.

Step 4  
Repeat process for all LUTs categories you wish to import.
